Purpose of Decision

To review the allocation of Executive functions in accordance with section 9E of the Local Government Act 2000.

Decision

That the delegation of Executive functions to officers as attached in the appendix be approved.

Reason

To ensure that the allocation of Executive Functions meets the requirements of the Council in terms of effective decision making and to reflect the amendments to the Council's organisational structure as approved at Council on 4th July 2022.

Background

Section 9E of the Local Government Act 2000 (as amended) ('the 2000 Act') gives authority to the Leader of the Council to arrange for Executive functions to be discharged by:

- himself or herself;
- the Cabinet:
- another member of the Cabinet;
- a committee of the Cabinet;
- an area committee, or
- an officer of the Council.

Councillor Jonathan Morgan was appointed as Leader of the Council on 21st May 2019 for the Council Term to 2019/23.

The Council's Constitution requires that any decision to change the allocation of Executive functions is reported for information to the next available meeting of the Council. In this particular case, it is anticipated that the matter will be reported to Council on 5th September 2022.

Proposals

Chapter 8.2 of the Constitution sets out the delegations of Council functions to officers which were approved by Council on 4th July 2022.

Chapter 8.3 of the Constitution sets out the delegations of Executive Functions to

Officers. Under this chapter various changes have been made to reflect the amendments to the Council's organisational structure as approved at Council on 4th July 2022.

These changes will be effective from 5th September 2022.
