

In Charnwood in 2011 the percentage of the population who identified themselves as white was 82.3 people (per 100 people), the percentage who identified as Asian or Asian British was 12.4 people (per 100 people), the percentage who identified as black or black British was 1.5 people (per 100 people), those who identified as mixed race made up 2.5 people (per 100 people) per cent of the population and those who identified as other ethnic group made up 1.2 people (per 100 people) per cent of the population.
