### **Report of the Chief Executive**

#### EXECUTIVE DECISIONS EXEMPTED FROM CALL-IN

##### Purpose of Report

To note decisions which were exempted from call-in in accordance with Scrutiny Committee Procedure 11.9.

##### Action Requested

In accordance with Full Council Procedure 9.11(d) questions may be asked of the Leader in relation to the decisions taken. The Leader may ask the relevant Lead Member to respond.

##### Policy Justification and Previous Decisions

The call-in procedure provides for a period of five clear working days during which councillors can ask for decisions taken by the Cabinet and individual Cabinet members, and key decisions taken by officers to be reviewed. With the agreement of the Chair of the Scrutiny Commission or in his/her absence the Mayor or Deputy Mayor) a decision can be exempted from call-in if the decision to be taken is both urgent and reasonable and the delay caused by the call-in process would not be in the interests of the Council or the public. Scrutiny Committee Procedure 11.9 requires that decisions that are exempted from call-in are reported to Council.

##### Local Plan commitment

On 13th July 2023 the Cabinet considered a report setting out the Borough Council's commitment to moving the draft Local Plan forward to a position where it can be considered by full Council for adoption.

The Chair of the Scrutiny Commission was consulted and agreed that the decision be exempted from call-in on the grounds that the Local Plan can move forward.

##### Contract for property cleaning and clearing including gardens and security services to tenanted and void properties

On 29th June 2023 the Director of Housing and Wellbeing took a an EXEMPT delegated decision to enter into a contract to deliver property cleaning and clearing including gardens and security services to tenanted and void properties.

The Chair of the Scrutiny Commission was consulted and agreed that the decision be exempted from call-in on the grounds that the additional support is needed to increase void properties being made available for re-letting as soon as possible.
