Jail for driver who caused death of his brother in village crash



A SPEEDING driver who killed two passengers in a crash - one of them his brother - has been jailed.

Scott Fitzgerald, 37, from Loughborough, pictured, hit a stone wall, causing his Range Rover to rotate into the path of an oncoming vehicle, in Forest Road,

Woodhouse, at 6.20pm on October 3.

He left the scene, leaving behind his fatally injured passengers, Shane Fitzgerald, 29, and 36-year-old Daniel Witheridge.

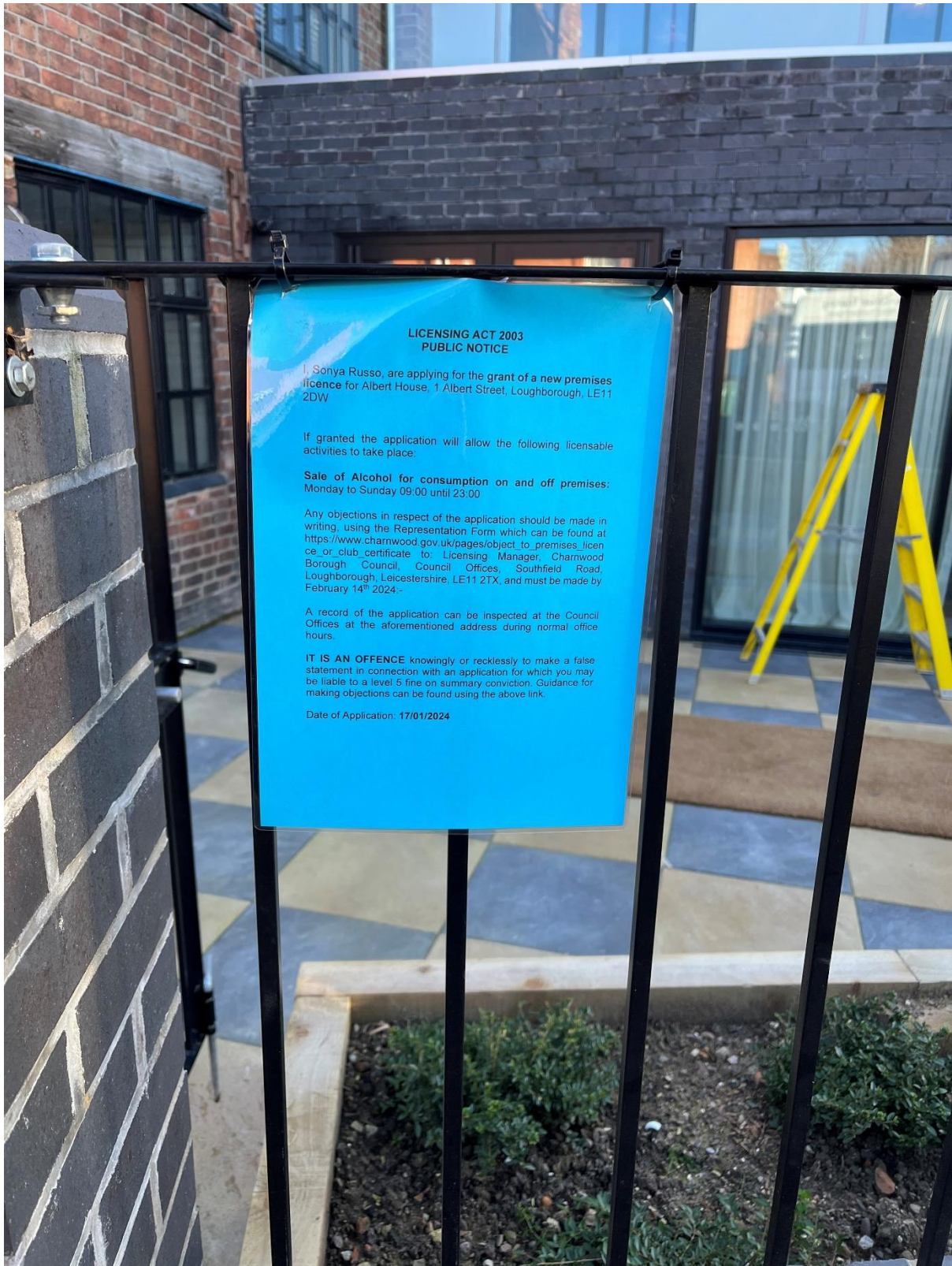

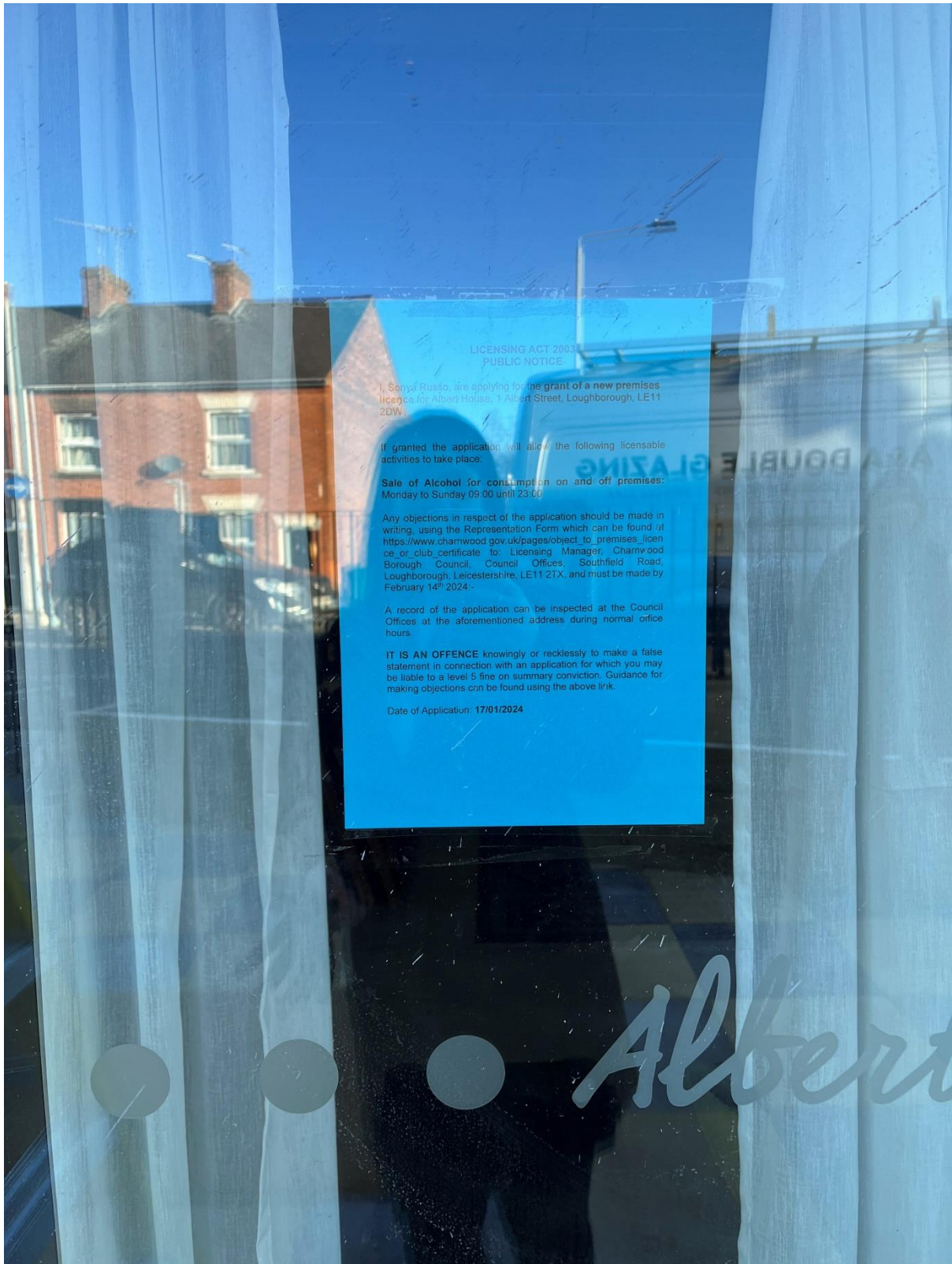
