I would like to appeal against your decision to apply for a Tree Preservation Order on the tree.



Approximately 45 years ago I built my bungalow at 3 Soar Road, Quorn. At that time the pine tree was approximately 5 feet tall and the adjacent boundary wall was in perfect condition.

Over the years as the tree has grown the wall began to lean towards the footpath on Soar Road. Eventually the wall collapsed on to the footpath and had to be re built at a cost of £3000.

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


The trunk of this tree is very close to the guttering on my carports which is another concern of mine. I feel climate change has had a part to play in the increased changes in this trees growth.

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





During high winds because the crown of the tree is so thick and high the movement of the trunk is becoming frightening.

The lowest branch overhangs a building at present. I think any raising of the crown would make the tree's centre of gravity even higher and more dangerous.
