Decision on the Application

In reaching its decision, the Sub-Committee has taken into consideration all relevant written and oral representations and submissions made. The Sub-Committee has had particular regard to the Licensing Objectives, in particular public nuisance.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Sub-Committee has also considered the representation made by the Objector that granting the licence would cause public nuisance, in particular, noise and parking problems.


DECISION AND REASONS

Parking was not a consideration for the Committee as they are only looking at the Licensing Act 2003. Whilst the Committee had heard the submitted concerns, they do not form part of the Licensing Objectives.

Committee was satisfied that the premises will be run in a way that promotes the Licensing Objectives and there was no evidence before them to suggest otherwise. The Premises Licence was granted.

There is a right to appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days from the date on which the party is notified of the determination of the decision of the Sub-Committee Panel.
