# Objection to the following Application

## Quorn Grange Hotel, 88 Wood Lane, Quorn, Leicestershire, LE12 8DB

Applicant: Richard Langham

**Details:** Applicant seeks to vary the current premise licence to show a new plan. No changes to licensable hours or activities. Last day for representations is July 8, 2020.

## **Objections sent under:**

Prevention of crime and disorder, Prevention of public nuisance, Public safety Together with the issue of no information to be able to assess the change

Unfortunately unlike other Town Planning Applications, Charnwood have not issued any details on the website, nor are there any details to be able to assess the impact of the changes on a sign just outside the Hotel Grounds, so I will have to comment on change that may affect our family and others in the local area.

- 1) There is only a statement that the licencing hours have not changed. This statement alone would not concern me should the hours only affect the inner building premises, however not knowing what they are I will have to assume that these hours are 7 days a week & could be up to 24 hours a day. Allowing this to be extended to the grounds would definitely affect the household and I would object vigorously for the licence to allow any external changes which did not limit the hours & number of days a year that the premises was allowed to use the grounds. The premises have, in the past, been used extensively for wedding receptions and celebrations. Extending these to the grounds could mean that they could have yearly permission to have some 150 plus nights of celebrations until extremely late. This I would object to vigorously.
- 2) The application is for Live Music and Performance of Plays. I have attended some live music in the courtyard and a play some time ago in the upper area. However, these were early in the evening & I have no objection to this, if arranged on occasion. I can only assume that applications for these in the past were using single applications of extension. I would ask what has changed that the Hotel could not continue in this manner? It would keep the restriction control capabilities within the Authorities hands should there be an increase in problems caused, as opposed to issuing a global licence that local residents would be required to continually write to Charnwood BC to take action should this happen.
- Live music covers a large range, from classical through folk to 3-day events. I would have no objection to single early evening live music events occasionally. However, any 1-3-day event I would object to completely. The road is not built for the traffic, the numbers could be extensive and serious disruption due to ongoing late-night loud noise would be unacceptable. By issuing a global licence we can see no reason why this would not be allowed every weekend.

So, without giving information that I can assess the impact of the change the Hotel & Charnwood BC have left me with no option but to object to any change from that which is in place at present.
