

**DECISION OF THE LEADER – JUNE 2022  
ADDENDUM**

PARTICIPATION IN THE UK RESETTLEMENT SCHEME

Purpose of Decision

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2021, the Leader approved a decision to enable the Council to participate in the UK Resettlement Scheme in 2021-2022. Due to the continued impact of the pandemic and the expansion and introduction of the new Afghan Resettlement Schemes the Council was unable to source a suitable property to meet the pledge.

The Leader is asked to amend the decision made on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2021 to enable the Council to participate in the UK Resettlement Scheme in 2022-2023.

Decision

To give delegated executive authority for the Head of Strategic and Private Sector Housing to pledge on behalf of the Council to house one family of up to 6 people in the private rented sector and participate in the UK Resettlement Scheme 2022-2023.

A recommendation is being made that the following delegated executive authority be given to the Head of Strategic and Private Sector Housing with immediate effect:

- To participate in the new UK Resettlement Scheme in 2022-2023 and house one family of up to 6 people in the private rented sector.

Reason

To enable the pledge made for the Council to participate in the UK Resettlement Scheme to begin in earnest.
